



Information on Data Processing to Applicants of medical ECONET GmbH Mandatory Information According to Art. 12 ff. DSGVO

On 25th February 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the new version of the Federal Data Protection Act (FDPR) come into force. With this information sheet, we are fulfilling our duty to inform in accordance with Art. 12 a.m. GDPR.

3. Collection and processing of personal data, purposes and legal basis as part of our application process, we collect and process in particular letters of motivation and cover letters, CVs and references. The collection of your personal data within the meaning of article 1 of the DSGVO, such as address data, date of birth and bank details, but also data about your specific career, etc., basically takes place with you. The processing of the personal data provided by you is carried out for the purpose of processing your application for the filling of positions within our company. For this purpose, it may also be necessary to process personal data that we have reliably received from third parties, for example from the employment agency or from Xing SE, and for the aforementioned purpose, or that we collect from third parties reliably and for the aforementioned purpose. The processing of your personal data is carried out by us. The encryption of your data when applying by email to m.angerstein@medical-econet.com depends on your email service provider.

Note on sensitive data

We expressly draw your attention to the fact that applications, in particular CVs, certificates and other data submitted to us, may contain particularly sensitive information about mental and physical health, racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, membership of a trade union or political party or sexual life. If such information is provided to us, you expressly agree that medical ECONET GmbH may process this data for the purpose of processing your application. This data will be processed in accordance with this privacy notice and other relevant legislation. No fully automated decision-making (including profiling) is used to process the data they provide.

4. Recipients and categories of recipients of the personal data:
Recipients and categories of recipients of your personal data to achieve the purpose are or may be according to our current application process: Responsible managing director, responsible supervisor as well as the respective personnel manager and administrator responsible for personnel matters.

Data transfer to a third country or an international organisation:

We do not intend to transfer your applicant data to countries outside the European union or to an international organisation.

5. Storage of personal data:
Your personnel data will be processed for as long as it is necessary to achieve the purpose for which it was collected. If your application is rejected, your personal data will be deleted no later than 6 months after completion of the application process. This does not apply if legal provisions prevent deletion or if further storage is necessary for the purpose of providing evidence or if you have consented to longer storage.

In the event of a positive decision on the establishment of an employment, your data will be further processed for the purpose of the subsequent implementation of an employment relationship, in compliance with the relevant legal provisions. Of course, you have the right to withdraw your application at any time.

7. Data subjects' rights:
You have the right

According to §26, 4.4 FDPR, Art. 7.3 GDPR revoke consent at any time and vis-à-vis anyone who has given it. This has the consequence that we may no longer continue the data processing based on this consent in the future;

According to Art. 15 GDPR request information about your personal data processed by us;

According to Art. 16 GDPR to obtain without delay the rectification of inaccuracies or the completion of your personal data stored by us;

According to Art. 17 GDPR request the deletion of your personal data stored by us, unless the processing is necessary for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and information, for compliance with a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or for the assertion, exercise of defence of legal claims;

According to §35 FDPR n. F., Art. 18 GDPR to request the restriction of the processing of your personal data, insofar as the correctness of the data is disputed by you, the processing is unlawful, but you refuse its deletion and we no longer require the data however, you need them to assert, exercise or defend legal claims, or you need them in accordance with Art. 21 GDPR, you have objected to the processing;

According to Art. 20 GDPR obtain the personal data you have provided to us in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format or request that it be transferred to another controller and

According to Art. 77 GDPR complain to a supervisory authority. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority of your usual place of residence or workplace.

8. Right of objection:
If your personal data are processed on the basis of legitimate interests pursuant to Art. 6.1.1e) or f) GDPR, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR, provided that there are reasons for doing so which arise from your personal situation.
